### 1. GOD CAN OPEN A DOOR FOR ANYBODY

### 2. GOD CAN OPEN A DOOR IN ANY CIRCUMSTANCE

### 3. GOD CAN OPEN DOORS VERY QUIETLY

*"I have placed before you an open door"*

(Revelation 3:8)
